

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Memphis Division of Police Services has been awarded grant funds in the amount of Seventy-Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$72,418.00) from the Shelby County District Attorney General's Office for the FY 2008 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will be used to support the Memphis Police Department PSN Unit in reviewing and investigating arrests and cases involving firearms; and

**WHEREAS**, these PSN project activities meet the criteria set forth under the Shelby County Anti-Gang Initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to accept the grant funding and amend the Fiscal Year 2009 Operating Budget to establish funds for the FY 2008 Project Safe Neighborhoods; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to appropriate the FY09 grant funds in the amount of Seventy-Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$72,418.00) for the. FY 2008 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Initiative.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Memphis that the FY 2008 Project Safe Neighborhoods funds in the amount of Seventy-Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighteen Dollars (\$72,418.00) be accepted by the City of Memphis.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Fiscal Year 2009 Operating Budget be and is hereby amended by appropriating the Expenditures and Revenues for the FY 200 Project Safe Neighborhoods in the amount of Seventy-Two Thousand Four Hundred Eighteen Dollars (~~\$112,418,000.00~~) as follows:
