Julie Raines attended the University of Tennessee and presently serves as the Chairman of the Board of her family business, Fischer Lime and Cement Company, which was founded in 1906. In addition, she operates Four Seasons as a consultant to Carlisle Collection, Ltd.

Julie has, throughout her life, been extremely active in volunteer and charitable activities. She is a past board member of the Woman's Guild of the Knoxville Symphony. She has been a member of the Junior League in Knoxville and Memphis serving on the executive board in Knoxville and holding various board positions in Memphis.

She co-chaired the 1994 Junior League Crystal Ball and was named Sustainer of the Year by the Memphis Junior League for her efforts.

In 1987, she served as co-chairman of volunteers for the Wonders exhibit of Ramesses, after which she was recognized as Volunteer of the Year by the Volunteer Center of the City of Memphis.
