

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Memphis Division of Fire Services has received grant funds in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$321,221.00) from the United States Department of Homeland Security Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to enhance the capabilities of State and local emergency preparedness and response personnel through the development of a State and urban area homeland security-training program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the grant funding and amend the Fiscal Year 2011 Operating Budget to establish funds for the Division of Fire Services; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the grant funds in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$321,221.00) from the United States Department of Homeland Security Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Memphis that the United States Department of Homeland Security Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program funds in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$321,221.00) be accepted by the City of Memphis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Year 2011 Operating budget be and is hereby amended by appropriating the Expenditures and Revenues from the United States Department of Homeland Security Metropolitan Medical Response System Grant Program funds in the amount of Three Hundred Twenty-One Thousand Two Hundred Twenty-One Dollars (\$321,221.00) as follows:
