



Memphis City Council Summary Sheet

Resolution seeking acceptance of federal grant funds in the amount of \$43,878.00 specifically for the Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Program. The PSN program in Shelby County is a coordinated effort between the District Attorney's Office, the U.S. Attorney's Office, the Memphis Police Department and other local law enforcement to crack down on illegal gun possession and gun-related crime.

- This item is a resolution to accept federal grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$43,878.00 specifically for the Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) program.
- The University of Memphis was the partner applicant for the 2009 PSN program and serves as the fiscal agent for the total project. The resolution references the City of Memphis, Division of Police Services sub award for the project.
- This is a new grant award pending Council acceptance.
- Acceptance and appropriation of the federal funds will require a contract with the University of Memphis for the sub award.
- Acceptance will require an amendment to the 2011 Operating Budget to appropriate the funds.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Memphis Division of Police Services has been awarded grant funds in the amount of Forty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars (\$43,878.00) from the University of Memphis for the FY2009 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Award; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to support the Memphis Police Department PSN Unit in reviewing and investigating arrests and cases involving firearms; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the grant funding and amend the FY2011 Operating Budget to establish funds for the FY2009 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Initiative; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the FY2011 grant funds in the amount of Forty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars (\$43,878.00) for the FY2009 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Initiative.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Memphis that the FY 2009 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Award in the amount of Forty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars (\$43,878.00) be accepted by the City of Memphis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Year 2011 Operating Budget be and is hereby amended by appropriating the Expenditures and Revenues for the FY2009 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Initiative in the amount of Forty Three Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Eight Dollars (\$43,878.00):
