



## Memphis City Council Summary Sheet

Resolution seeking acceptance of federal grant funds in the amount of \$101,875.00 specifically for the Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Program. The PSN program The PSN program in Shelby County is a coordinated effort between the District Attorney's Office, the U.S. Attorney's Office, the Memphis Police Department and other local law enforcement to crack down on illegal gun possession and gun-related crime.

- This item is a resolution to accept federal grant funds from the U.S. Department of Justice in the amount of \$101,875.00 specifically for the Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) program.
- The City of Memphis Division of Police Services was the applicant for the 2010 PSN program and serves as the fiscal agent for the total project. The City will make a sub award to the District Attorney General's Office for the project.
- This is a new grant award pending Council acceptance.
- Sub awarding to the District Attorney General's Office will require a contract.
- Acceptance will require an amendment to the 2011 Operating Budget to appropriate the funds.

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the City of Memphis Division of Police Services has been awarded grant funds in the amount of One Hundred One Thousand Eight Seventy Five Dollars (\$101,875.00) from the U.S. Department of Justice for the FY2010 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Award; and

**WHEREAS**, these funds will be used to support the Memphis Police Department PSN Unit in reviewing and investigating arrests and cases involving firearms; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to accept the grant funding and amend the FY2011 Operating Budget to establish funds for the FY2010 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Initiative; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to appropriate the FY2011 grant funds in the amount of One Hundred One Thousand Eight Seventy Five Dollars (\$101,875.00) for the FY2010 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Initiative.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Memphis that the FY 2010 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Award in the amount of One Hundred One Thousand Eight Seventy Five Dollars (\$101,875.00) be accepted by the City of Memphis.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Fiscal Year 2011 Operating Budget be and is hereby amended by appropriating the Expenditures and Revenues for the FY2010 Project Safe Neighborhoods (PSN) Initiative in the amount of One Hundred One Thousand Eight Seventy Five Dollars (\$101,875.00):
