

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Memphis did approve the Fiscal Year 2008 Operating Budget for the Police Organized Crime Unit in the amount of \$3,835,250.00 on June 5, 2007 of which \$700,000.00 of State and Federal Drug Funds had been approved to purchase Vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Division has a need to purchase an additional 14 cars with the total cost of \$300,000.00 for the Police Criminal Apprehension Team which has been created to focus an attack on crime in places where it is occurring and to support Investigative Services and the Organized Crime Unit by apprehending and arresting suspects in felony and drug cases; and

**WHEREAS**, the Police Organized Crime Unit has the \$300,000.00 in Drug Enforcement Fund under Drug Enforcement State in Reserves to fund the additional purchase of the 14 vehicles.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Memphis that there be and is hereby amended the Fiscal Year 2008 Operating Budget for the Police Organized Crime Unit in the amount of \$300,000.00 to purchase 14 Police cars, chargeable to the FY 2008 Operating Budget and credited as follows:
