

Through Healy's strategic guidance his team has developed processes that have effectively improved productivity, increased quality improvement controls, enhanced customer service and reduced long term and short term operating costs. Some of these business processes include the design and execution of route optimization algorithms, system wide GPS equipment tracking, real-time hub scanning systems and enhancements to shipment content and documentation data retrieval. Healy assumed his current position in March 2008 and has over 24 years of experience in the transportation industry.
