RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Memphis Division of Fire Services has received grant funds in the amount of Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand Four Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$317,419.00) from the U.S Department of Homeland Security, through Shelby County Office of Preparedness – Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Program; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to enhance the capabilities of State and Local Emergency Preparedness and Response personnel through the development of a State and Urban are Homeland Security Training program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the grant funding and amend the Fiscal Year 2012 Operating Budget to establish funds for the Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Program; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the grant funds in the amount of Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand Four Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$317,419.00) for the Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Memphis that the Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Cooperative Agreement funds in the amount of Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand Four Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$317,419.00) be accepted by the City of Memphis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Year 2012 Operating Budget be and is hereby amended by appropriating the Expenditures and Revenues for the Metropolitan Medical Response System (MMRS) Program in the amount of Three Hundred Seventeen Thousand Four Hundred Nineteen Dollars (\$317,419.00) as follows:
