FINANCIAL HARDSHIP WAIVER

Instructions

Motorists may be eligible for a one year financial hardship waiver for a vehicle that fails the Memphis Vehicle Emissions Inspection if the household's income falls within the income guidelines. The hardship waiver is one time only for the life of the vehicle. The vehicle must be repaired for the next year inspection cycle.

To qualify for a financial hardship waiver:

1. The vehicle must be currently registered in applicant's name. Provide copy of registration.
2. Copy of a valid Tennessee driver's license.
3. The motorist must provide a completed Financial Hardship Waiver Application.
4. A current failed vehicle inspection test with the past thirty (30) days.
5. A type written estimate for the vehicle emission related repairs from an Automotive Service Excellence (ASE) repair technician.
6. Meet the income guidelines listed below:

- * 1 person up to \$16,245
- * 2 persons up to \$21,855
- * 3 persons up to \$27,465
- * 4 persons up to \$33,075
- * 5 persons up to \$38,685
- * 6 persons up to \$44,295
- * 7 persons up to \$49,905
- * 8 persons up to \$55,515
