RESOLUTION TO APPROPRIATE FY13 CIP FUNDS FOR PREVENTIVE
MAINTENANCE FOR THE MEMPHIS AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY

- This item is a resolution to appropriate FY13 CIP for preventive maintenance for the Memphis Area Transit Authority.
- MATA initiated the request for the City Council to appropriate the FY13 CIP funds.
- This is not a change to an existing ordinance or resolution.
- This does not require MATA to award a new contract or amend an existing contract.
- On August 21, 2012, the appropriation request was presented to the City Council Public Works, Transportation and General Services Committee.
- Yes, this item requires an expenditure of funds in the amount of \$2,314,602; however, no contracts or budget amendments are required.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Memphis did include Preventive Maintenance, Project Number GA03018, as part of the Fiscal Year 2013 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) budget; and

WHEREAS, The funds will help the Memphis Area Transit Authority cover costs associated with maintenance of capital assets in Fiscal Year 2013; and

WHEREAS, It is necessary to appropriate \$2,314,602 funded by G. O. Bonds - General in Preventive Maintenance, Project Number GA03018 to fund preventive maintenance costs during Fiscal Year 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED By the Council of the City of Memphis that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of \$2,314,602 funded by G. O. Bonds - General chargeable to the Fiscal Year 2012 Capital Improvement Budget and credited as follows:
