

## CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, Memphis In May International Festival, Inc., has filed an application to have its Memphis In May Festival on Saturday, April 26, 2008 beginning at 12:01 a.m. through Sunday, May 25, 2008 at 11:59 p.m.; and needs permission to erect temporary structures on the street, we petition the Council of the City of Memphis for said permission; and

**WHEREAS**, Memphis In May International Festival, Inc. sponsors this event annually to promote Memphis and international cultures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the City of Memphis has the authority under City Ordinance 4576 (7)(b) to grant permission for temporary structures in the streets.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that trailers, port-o-lets, tents, barrels, delineators, reflective barricades, and signage is to be placed to denote closures/two-way traffic during this event on the city streets as indicated on the application.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that in each case streets will be opened before the listed time if the streets are cleared and approved by the Memphis Police Department, Traffic Bureau.
