

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Memphis Division of Police Services has been awarded grant funds in the amount of Five Hundred Ninety Two Thousand One Hundred Forty Three Dollars and 50 Cents (\$ 592,143.50) from the Bureau of Justice Assistance through the Shelby County Government; and

WHEREAS, these funds will be used to prevent and control crime; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to accept the grant funding and amend the Fiscal Year 2008 Operating Budget to establish funds for the 2007 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate the grant funds in the amount of Five Hundred Ninety Two Thousand One Hundred Forty Three Dollars and 50 Cents (\$ 592,143.50) for the 2007 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Memphis that the 2007 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Project funds in the amount of Five Hundred Ninety Two Thousand One Hundred Forty Three Dollars and 50 Cents (\$ 592,143.50) be accepted by the City of Memphis.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fiscal Year 2008 Operating Budget be and is hereby amended by appropriating the Expenditures and Revenues for the 2007 Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Project in the amount of Five Hundred Ninety Two Thousand One Hundred Forty Three Dollars and 50 Cents (\$ 592,143.50) as follows:
