

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the City of Memphis owns and maintains Forrest Park and the various features located within the park; and

WHEREAS, the University of Tennessee (UT) is physically located on all sides of Forrest Park, uses Forrest Park extensively, and would like to assist the City of Memphis by providing certain maintenance, security and other enhancements to Forrest Park which will benefit UT students, faculty, staff and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City of Memphis, without granting any exclusivity of use, agrees to allow UT to provide additional maintenance, security and other enhancements to Forrest Park; and

WHEREAS, UT will furnish labor, tools and equipment to provide grounds and routine maintenance for Forrest Park located at Madison Avenue and Dunlap Street which shall include, but not be limited to litter pick-up, grass mowing, trimming and routine tree and shrubbery maintenance at the same or higher level of service as the City; and

WHEREAS, the period of this agreement shall be for one (1) year and will be renewed annually absent termination by either party; and

WHEREAS, this agreement specifically retains the public use by the general public in Forrest Park; and

WHEREAS, City of Memphis Ordinance No. 4763, Article 1, Section 23-1(d) requires the approval of the Council of the City of Memphis to enter into this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Memphis that this Agreement between the City of Memphis and University of Tennessee for the maintenance of Forrest Park is hereby approved in accordance with the terms set forth therein.
